

TURKEY HUNTING

1. Private Land Consent Forms should be completely filled out prior to being signed by any of the authorized Club Executive Board members or Committee Chairmen. These forms can be signed by either the Club President, the Vice President, and any of the Stonington Wildlife/Habitat, Game Committee, North Stonington Grounds and North Stonington House/Barn chairmen.
2. Hunting by family members (Eligible family members are the spouse, and children, grandchildren, and stepchildren who are under 18 years old) is allowed on the Voluntown/North Stonington property. Family members must have their own, signed Private Land Consent forms and can only hunt when accompanied by the related Club member. A Club member may accompany only one Family member at a time. The Club member is responsible for the actions of their family members.
3. The bag limit on the Club's Voluntown/North Stonington property is no more than three turkeys per member per calendar year independent of the total allowed by the Connecticut DEEP turkey hunting laws and regulations. Turkeys taken by Family members apply to the member's annual Club three bird bag limit.
4. Adult Family members must hunt within 100 yards of the related Club member to allow easy verbal communication. Family members holding a Connecticut Junior Hunting License must hunt in the immediate vicinity of the related Club member to allow full supervision at all times.
5. Turkey hunting shall be conducted in accordance with all Connecticut Hunting Laws and Regulations.
6. Turkey hunters hunting at the Voluntown/North Stonington property must sign in and out in accordance with the Voluntown/North Stonington Grounds Rules.
